The rosé at Château Le Puy is made by the "saignée" method. Each vat is tasted at the beginning of fermentation, and only the most suitable are selected for this unique cuvée. The juice is then fermented and aged in barrels for 6 to 10 months before bottling. The wine is bottled without filtration and no sulfur is added at any point. This less technical process, along with the extended élevage, makes the "Rose-Marie" a serious and soulful Rosé. Bright, with delicate, sweet red fruits, it is wonderful to drink upon release but has the depth to allow for aging. Limited in production, only 30 cases are made available for the United States.

## ambro: macerated & orange

-An ancient technique for producing wine dating back to 3000 BC; white grapes are left in contact with their skins for an extended period of time resulting in a fuller, more tannic, & pleasantly unusual wine with an amber hue.

**Trebbiano/Ansonica/Malvasia**, Ampeleia 'Bianco di Ampeleia', Costa Toscana 2021 44 **N/W**

-With only 10 days skin contact – not enough to extract real tannins – this is a perfect introduction to orange wine. Balanced and bright on the palate with notes of orange peel, golden apple, pear, citrus, and herbs.

**Albana**, San Biaggio Vecchio 'Sabbia Gialla' Ravenna Bianco, Emilia Romagna 2019 49 **N**

-Rich and complex aromas of citrus fruits, white flowers, honey, and aromatic herbs. Vibrant minerality and juicy acidity.

**Sauvignon Blanc/Sangiovese**, Ficomontanino 'Zacinta Revi', Toscana 2021 55 **N/W\***

-Vibrant and aromatic with complexity and texture. Tangerine, anise, and musky flowers supported by firm minerality and tangy acidity.

**Albanello/Zibibbo**, Occhipinti 'SP68 Bianco', Sicilia 2020 55 **N/W\***

-From the talented young natural wine maker Arianna Occhipinti, this golden wine is intensely aromatic and complex with a mix of wild flower, macerated peach, & aromatic herbs. Mineral driven palate, noteworthy tannins and savory flavors of dried apricot, preserved citrus and sage.

**Insolia/Grecanico**, COS 'Rami', Sicilia 2020 55 **N\***

-Intriguing, deep white with aromas of fresh sea air, hints of dried honey, rising bread dough and crisp golden delicious apple. On the palate, Rami manages to be both rich, elegant and evanescent at the same time, with the wine's great natural acidity bringing balance to its white Burgundy-like texture.

**Trebbiano**, Francesco Cirelli Trebbiano d'Abruzzo Anfora, Abruzzo 2018 55 **N\***

-Prolonged skin contact and 1 year aging in amphora give a depth of subtle baked exotic fruit, crushed herbs, spices, and honeycomb without any hint of sweetness.

**Catarratto**, Il Censo, Praruar Terre Siciliane Bianco, Sicilia 2018 66 **N\***

-Legendary Giampiero Bea collaborated with the Gargano family to produce this outstanding natural wine. Aromas and flavors of baked apricot, orange peel, herbal and salty notes, some nuttiness and refreshing acidity.

**Trebbiano/Malvasia/Verdicchio**, Monastero Suore Cistercensi 'Coenobium Bianco', Lazio 2019 55 **N/W\***

-This organic vineyard north of Rome is lovingly tended by a small group of Cistercian nuns. They produce this unique wine with the assistance of legendary 'natural' winemaker, Giampiero Bea. The Bianco is complex with an oxidative quality that blankets layers of minerals, nuttiness, acidity & a dry palate with flavors of apple pie, toasted pecans, honey, and citrus.

**Chenin Blanc**, Nicolas Joly, Les Vieux Clos, Savennières, Loire 2013 82 **N\***

-From the legendary pioneer of the biodynamic wine movement, this unconventional wine is deep golden with nutty aromas, a peppery minerality & flavors of baked apple & spice. A bright acidity balances the rich texture. Decant this wine.

**Umbria Bianco**, Paolo Bea 'Santa Chiara', Umbria 2017 88 **N\***

-Rainier cherries, white stone fruits, and melon waft with savory minerals, toffee, licorice and white flower petals in this indescribable, opulent and spicy orange wine from Giampiero Bea, the master himself. (Grechetto, Malvasia, Chardonnay, Sauvignon, Garganega)

**Sémillon**, Pueyo 'Hellébore', Bordeaux 2017 110 **N\***

-Bordeaux's first iconic orange wine. Only 1000 bottles produced. Unfined, unfiltered, no added sulfites. Rich and complex, ripe and inviting on the nose, full of quince, ripe pear, red grapefruit. The tannins are soft, spicy, and the fruit lasts and lasts on the finish, balanced by savory minerality and acidity.

**Trebbiano Spoletino**, Paolo Bea 'Lapideus', Umbria 2018 115 **N\***

-Arising from a cooler microclimate than the 'Arboreus', 'Lapideus' spent 35 days on its skins, followed by 210 days on the gross lees. Edgy and lively, exhibiting exotic and savory nuance, notes of apricots, cloves, and candied ginger.

**Ribolla Gialla**, Gravner, Friuli-Venezia Giulia 2007 130 **N\***

-From Josko Gravner, the visionary maverick "King of Friulian Wines". The grapes are fermented in Georgian amphorae buried underground for long maceration with wild yeasts and no temperature control. After fermentation the wine rests in amphorae for five more months and then it is aged in large oak barrels for an additional six years and bottled without fining or filtering. Delivers dried apricot, orange zest, salinity, anise, dried herbs, nuts, and a blast of smoky minerality. Complex and tannic.
